Supply List

- •1 Lead Holder for 2mm leads (not a mechanical pencil)
- •1 Lead Pointer for the lead holder (this is the sharpener)
- •"Clic" pencil-style eraser (at office supply stores, for example)
- •X-acto knife (any shape blade is OK)
- •Portable drawing board or foamcore support (for 8 ½" x 11" paper)
- Battery operated portable light (entirely optional)
